Setup

Wire Confirmation Setup


S279350- CertifID Account 1-to-1 Mapping

You can now map **AIM+** accounts to **CertifID** accounts, using new **1-to-1 mapping** in AIM+. This feature also gives you the ability to view your CertifID account information from the *CertifID User* drop-down.

In addition, a new **Associated AIM+ Login Name** field has been added to *Wire Confirmation Setup* to give you the ability to map your AIM+ login name with your **CertifID** account.

Note: You will only be allowed to see CertifID account information associated with one AIM+ login name.

After you get the new user consent, the following **Wire Confirmation Account Setup** screen will appear. The CeritifID user will be linked automatically to logged in AIM user and if you already consented, no additional steps are needed.




Closing

S119358- Place of Settlement Button

The **Place of Settlement** button is now enabled when you select **Closing Disclosure** as the **Settlement Statement** in the *Closing* module of the **AIM+** file. Once enabled, the existing **Place of Settlement** dialog box displays, giving you the ability to provide different physical addresses for closing. Previously, this button was only available for **HUD Statements**.

For ALTA Statements, Settlement Agent address will be fetched from Place of Settlement.




Policies – Stewart Access Only

S266278 - Editing the Municipal Code for Stewart Access Policies

You can now change the municipal code on **Stewart Access policies and endorsements** from the *Policies* section of **AIM+** if the correct code is not automatically selected.

From the *Policies* screen, use the **Municipality** drop-down to select the correct municipal code. The codes that display in the **Municipality** drop-down are received from Stewart Access and viewable in AIM+.



Documents

S276590 - PDF to Word Conversion

Previously, there were formatting issues when saving **AIM+ Documents** to **Microsoft Word** in the *Documents* module of **AIM+**. With this enhancement, there is an upgrade to the process which resolved multiple formatting issues. In addition, links within documents should no longer break.
